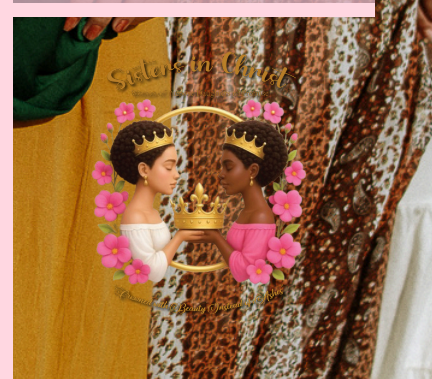
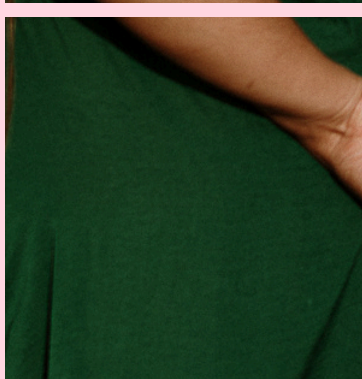
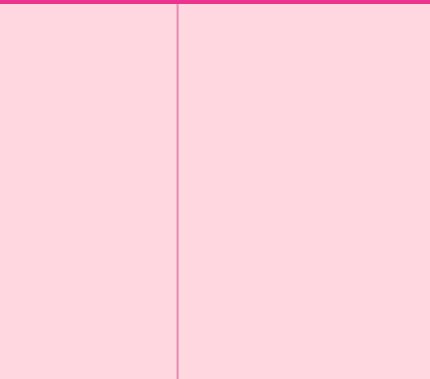
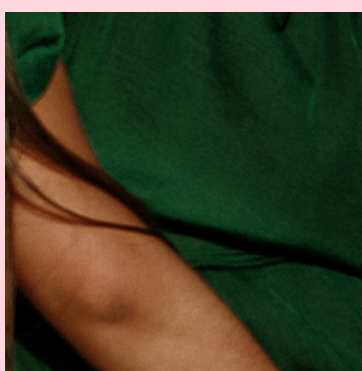
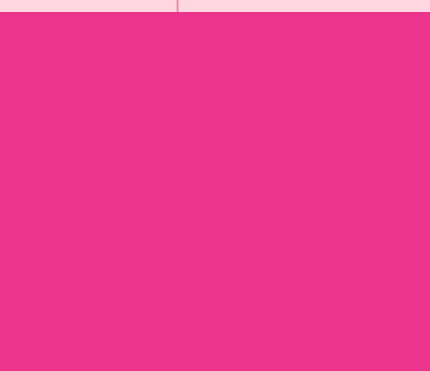
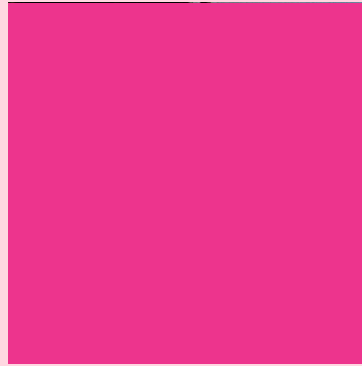
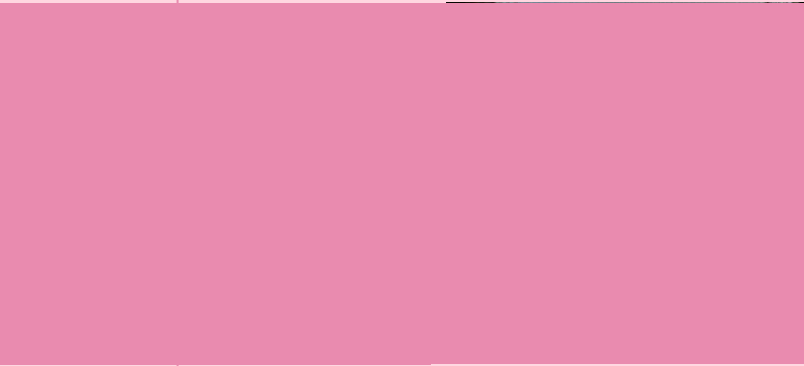


Sisters in Christ: Women of Purpose, Daughters of Promise Annual Report

Dear Sisters, Partners, and Supporters,

As we reflect on 2025, my heart is overflowing with gratitude for all God has done through Sisters in Christ: Women of Purpose, Daughters of Promise. This year has been one of extraordinary growth, deepened impact, and undeniable evidence of God's hand guiding our ministry.

After we entered Q4, we reached a major milestone that strengthened our foundation for future growth—our official 501(c)(3) nonprofit status, granted in midOctober. That moment marked the beginning of a new era, and this year we witnessed the fruit of that foundation.

Just one week after receiving our nonprofit status, we launched the Promise Pantry, a compassion-driven initiative providing groceries and essential support to women and children in need. To date, we have served nearly 20 women and children, ensuring that no daughter of promise walks alone in her time of need.

Our weekly virtual Bible Study has continued to flourish, offering a sacred space for teaching, fellowship, and spiritual growth. What began with just five women has now grown into a powerful sisterhood of over 150 women in only six months. Across our social media platforms, we have ministered to nearly 1,000 women, extending encouragement, prayer, and biblical truth to those seeking hope and direction.

This year, we also strengthened the organizational structure of our ministry by establishing three major pillars:

- The Vision & Legacy Office: stewarding long-term impact, outreach, philanthropy, and generational transformation,
- Kingdom Impact: expanding discipleship

Each of these pillars represents a commitment to excellence, sustainability, and Kingdom advancement.

As we close out 2025, I am filled with expectation for what God will do in 2026. We are stepping into a year of expansion, innovation, and deeper impact. Thank you for your prayers, generosity, and unwavering support. Together, we are building a legacy that will bless generations.

2026 Initiatives

Pink Care Bags

In honor of Breast Cancer Awareness Month, we blessed a local Cancer Center in Michigan with 45 pink care bags. Each bag was thoughtfully filled with pink essential items chosen to uplift, comfort, and honor women who are both survivors and courageous fighters of breast cancer. This outreach reflected our commitment to standing with women in every season of their journey—offering hope, encouragement, and tangible expressions of Christ's love. We celebrate the strength of these women and remain dedicated to supporting them with compassion and purpose.

Promise Pantry

The Promise Pantry continued to serve women and children by providing groceries and essential household support to families experiencing food insecurity. Since its launch, the pantry has directly impacted nearly 20 families, meeting immediate needs while offering dignity, care, and encouragement. As demand continues to grow, plans are underway to expand pantry services in 2026, strengthening the ministry's ability to serve more families and deepen its commitment to holistic care that supports physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being.

Weekly Virtual Bible Study

The ministry's weekly virtual Bible study, held every Tuesday evening, has become a powerful and consistent space for teaching, healing, and spiritual growth. What began as a small gathering of five women has grown into a vibrant sisterhood of more than 150 participants within six months. This steady growth reflects a deep hunger for connection, discipleship, and faith-centered community. The Bible study continues to foster meaningful relationships, strengthen spiritual foundations, and provide a welcoming environment where women can grow together in faith and purpose.

Community Reach

Through intentional digital outreach, the ministry has ministered to nearly 1,000 women across social media platforms. This growing online presence has expanded access to prayer support, mentorship, encouragement, and discipleship pathways for women who may not otherwise be reached through in-person programming. In alignment with Breast Cancer Awareness initiatives, online engagement has also served as a channel for education, advocacy, and community-building, extending the ministry's reach beyond geographic boundaries.

Organizational Growth

In 2025, the organization experienced significant internal growth through the strengthening of key departments, including the Vision & Legacy Office and Kingdom Impact. Strategic investments in leadership, structure, and systems have laid a strong foundation for long-term sustainability and generational impact. By building organizational infrastructure alongside programmatic growth, the ministry is positioning itself to steward its mission faithfully, expand its reach, and ensure lasting impact for years to come.

Increasing capacity to serve more women and children with groceries, emergency support, and seasonal assistance.

Strengthening Kingdom Impact

Launching new outreach initiatives, community partnerships, and service opportunities.

Expansion of the Vision & Legacy Office

Introducing two new initiatives designed to deepen generational impact: Pieces of Purpose & The Crowned & Called Career Institute.

Pieces of Purpose

Pieces of Purpose is a Christ-centered initiative dedicated to supporting mothers raising children on the autism spectrum. Inspired by the CEO and Founder's daughter, Journei, who has an ASD diagnosis, this program was birthed from a place of love, faith, and lived experience.

Through practical resources, developmental tools, and spiritual encouragement, Pieces of Purpose equips mothers to navigate the unique journey of autism with grace, confidence, and community—celebrating the truth that every child is fearfully and wonderfully made.



The Crowned & Called Career Institute

The Crowned & Called Career Institute is a purpose-driven training and empowerment hub designed to prepare women for professions that align with both their skills and their God-given calling. More than career readiness, it's about equipping women to step into workplaces with confidence, excellence, and spiritual authority—transforming jobs into platforms for impact and legacy.



How It Works

1. Apply

Interested mentors and mentees complete a short application to help us understand their goals, needs, and areas of growth.

2. Get Matched

Our team prayerfully reviews applications and pairs mentees with mentors based on spiritual alignment, life experience, and personal development goals.

3. Connect & Grow

Mentor-mentee pairs meet regularly, virtually or in person, to build relationships, set goals, and grow together through guided conversations, prayer, and shared resources.

4. Engage in Community

Participants are invited to monthly gatherings, workshops, and service opportunities to deepen their connection and grow

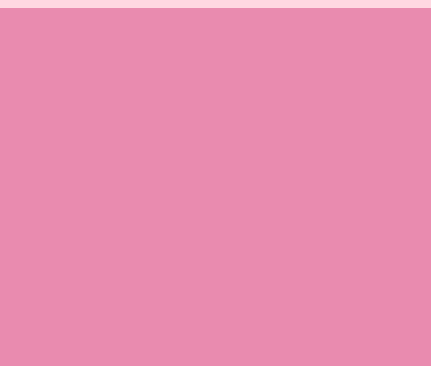
